To the Honourable Members of the House of Assembly in Parliament Assembled –

The Petition of the undersigned residents of Adelaide and greater South Australia:

We draw the attention of your Honourable House to the proposed privatisation of the Motor Vehicle Registry. Putting personal information into the hands of profit-driven private companies could jeopardise the security of citizens' personal data linked to their driver's licences, such as bank details and even medical conditions. Cost cutting by any private entity could lead to reduced local face-to-face services and further office closures beyond the already foreshadowed shutdown of Mitcham, Modbury and Prospect – offices which must be maintained.

Request

Your petitioners therefore request that your Honourable House will urge the Government to retain the Motor Vehicle Registry and all its functions under public control, to especially protect personal data from being used for private profit, and keep all Service SA offices open, preserving face-to-face services upon which people rely.
